

Frequently Asked Questions...

[Will I always get a beautiful picture of my baby?](#)

At CWAHA, we will always do our very best to capture great pictures, but they may not always be perfect. If your baby is not in a good position it will be difficult to see your baby's face. Please keep in mind we cannot make promises that the images we obtain will be similar to any you have seen elsewhere. Everyone scans differently. We promise to make every effort to obtain the best possible images of whatever parts of your baby we can see.

[When is the best time to come in for my 4D ultrasound appointment?](#)

Between 27-30 weeks. Prior to 24 weeks the fat has not yet defined the baby. Truly beautiful 4D ultrasound images require fat deposits and fetal development.

[How many ultrasounds are obtained during my pregnancy?](#)

Typically, 2 scans (not including 3D/4D) sometimes more, if medically necessary.

[Can I bring friends and family to my ultrasound appointment?](#)

Absolutely! We are a family friendly environment. We understand the importance of having family and friends to share in this special moment. Therefore, each of our rooms can accommodate your family members and friends.

[Can you tell the gender of my baby?](#)

Yes! Gender determination is most accurate if made after 20 weeks.

[How far in advance should ultrasound appointments be made?](#)

Ultrasound appointments should be made a few weeks ahead.

[Is ultrasound safe?](#)

Yes, and has been in routine use for over thirty-five years. While no detrimental effects from ultrasounds have been definitively proven, the FDA and American Institute of Ultrasound in Medicine openly discourage the use of ultrasound unless medically necessary.
